

# IFR Surveys

- Responses:
  - Online Survey Application is currently being updated by WUGs and WWPs
  - 37 (17%) have completed the survey as of August 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - 36 surveys returned in 2006 Plan



- Total requested is \$2.7 Billion
  - (23%) of \$12 Billion estimated
  - \$112 Million in 2006 Plan
- · Results are discussed in Chapter 9



#### **IFR Surveys**

- The cumulative total of financial assistance currently requested is \$2,730,442,272
- Most entities requested funding from the WIF-Construction Program
- The projects identified in the survey anticipate that funding will be required as early as 2011 and as late as 2040
